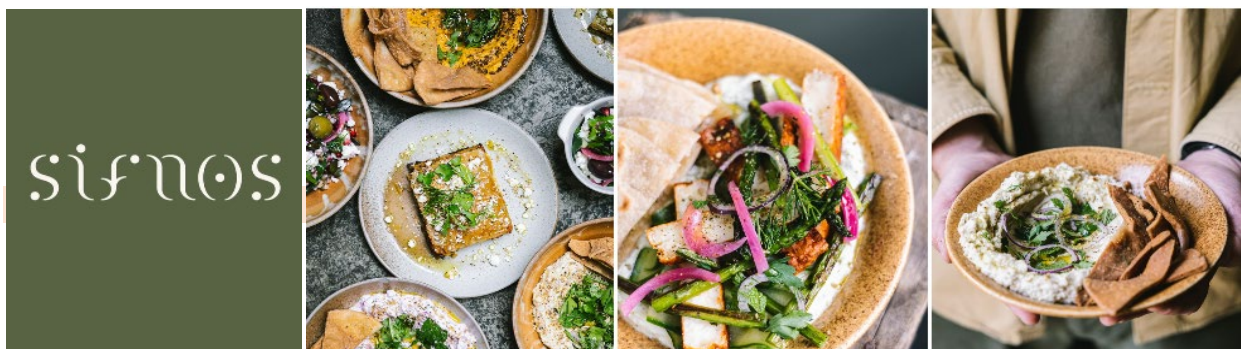
The restaurant, the second in the Samos Greek Food group, which already has a presence in Bordeaux's Saint-Michel district, offers home-cooked cuisine using locally sourced, seasonal produce, with a selection of the best of Greece from the Kalios house. Customers can enjoy a nomadic cuisine where Greek cuisine is reinvented in a creative, surprising, practical and convivial way.

The restaurant is open for lunch every day from Monday to Friday and offers an *afterwork* service on Thursday evenings.

The Cité Numérique in brief

20,000 m² of offices, 3,000 m² of flexible Wellio spaces, 2,000 m² of services and 8,500 m² of outdoor space: the Cité Numérique, ideally located near Bordeaux Saint-Jean station, is a vast ecosystem that brings together start-ups, incubators, leading digital companies and public bodies.

Supported by EPA Bordeaux Euratlantique and designed by Bordeaux Métropole in close collaboration with Bègles town council and the Nouvelle Aquitaine region, La Cité Numérique is 75% owned by Covivio, which has taken up the challenge, launched in 2019, of making this site the heart of the digital economy in the Nouvelle Aquitaine region.
